Dear Parishioners,

I am immensely grateful to the parishioners whose faithful stewardship of finance allows our facility to be maintained so our parish can move forward in its mission of being the Salt Of The Earth and The Light Of The World. Thank you for everything you do!

Over the past year, our parish has completed many building and maintenance projects that needed to be done for many years. We installed new LED lights throughout the Church and Family Life Center; new flooring was installed in the Parish Office, the DRE's office, the confessional, and the small chapel; new icons were purchased to adorn the small chapel to make it more beautiful; and, a new roof was put on the rectory. We also had to deal with the many leaks during the storms. The staff and other parish volunteers were pivotal in helping to address these needs.

The total spent on these projects exceeded what we have received from our United in Faith pledges. The difference was paid from the parish's operational funds. As a result, money from our investment portfolio is needed to maintain our ongoing operational needs.

I have consulted with the Finance Council and other highly involved parishioners here at Resurrection to consider our options to replenish what was spent on these maintenance items. We have decided to run a campaign to raise the \$53,000 spent. I am confident that our parishioners will rise to the occasion and contribute so that our parish can continue to be on solid financial footing.
